Merit Scholarship

The Merit Scholarship scheme was introduced by the Mar Thoma Church Educational Society in the year 2005-06. It is awarded to students on the basis of the marks obtained in the Annual Examination and also for their achievements in Extracurricular Activities. The scholarship is awarded to the students from classes VI-XII, based on the criteria fixed by the management. In Std VI & VII, candidates who get 90% or above in each subject in the annual examination are considered. In Std VIII, IX & XII, candidates who obtain 80% marks in each subject are considered. For Std XI, the merit scholarship is awarded to a student who has passed the Std X board examination from one of the St.Thomas schools and has become the topper. A maximum of 50 marks will be added to the academic marks for extracurricular activities. The scheme serves to motivate the students to better their performance in the various examinations and also to participate actively in extracurricular activities.

Curriculum and Syllabus

The primary section forms the strong base of the school. It enables the academic growth of the school to advance in further stages. A common curriculum is being followed in classes I to IV in St Thomas Campus. Opportunities are provided for our students to learn three languages (English, Malayalam & Hindi), Computer Science, Environmental Studies and core subjects. Regular Worksheets, Monthly tests, Mid Term and Terminal Examinations assess the academic growth and progress of students. Counselling sessions were arranged for students and parents. Onam, Children's Day and Christmas were celebrated. Class assemblies for classes I-VII were conducted on Tuesdays and bench - wise assemblies on Thursdays. Literary, Arts and Sports competitions were organized. For classes I-IV competitions in quiz, elocution, hand writing, reading and spelling were held on an **inter class** basis and for V, VI & VII competitions in quiz, drama (English & Malayalam) debate and reading skill were held on an **inter house** basis The Children were given a chance to showcase their creative ability by bringing out class magazines with the help of their class teachers. Students participated in National level

competitive Examinations like Cyber Olympiad and Maths Olympiad. A Junior Choir functions under the able guidance and training of Mr. Bejoy Mathew, the choir master of the campus.

The Upper Primary and the High School section comes under the Department of General Education, Govt. of Kerala and under the direct control of the DPI. The SCERT syllabus followed is in tune with the National curriculum frame work which gives emphasis to the all-round development of the child. The grading system was introduced in 2005 and the students are subjected to a continuous evaluation process which stretches throughout the year. Emphasis is given to activity oriented learning through continuous evaluation activities such as projects, assignments, seminars, practicals and creative writing. In addition to the core subjects, three languages and Information Technology forms part of the curriculum.

At the Higher Secondary Level the NCERT text books are followed for the core subjects. Language books are prescribed by the SCERT. The School prepares boys and girls for the Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the Directorate of Higher Secondary Education. A Board Examination is held at the end of Std XI and the marks obtained are added to the Std XII Board examination marks. Admission is offered to the students in the three streams: – (i) Maths, Physics, Chemistry & Computer Science (ii) Maths, Physics, Chemistry & Biology and (iii) Commerce.

We express our heartfelt gratitude to the officials of the Education Department - the AEO, DEO, DD, DPI and the Director of Higher Secondary Education for their visits and guidance.

Remedial classes and Reviews

Students in need of remedial help were noted immediately after the first monthly test. The gifted, the average, and the below average were identified for every subject and the necessary steps taken. Review for weak students of Std VIII to XII was held on a termly basis.

School Assembly

Morning Assembly is conducted thrice a week. The students are given the opportunity to conduct the assembly class- wise with a view to bringing out their talents. Bible Reading, Message, News Updates and 'Thought for the day' form part of the morning assembly. Apart from these, special days such as Children's' Day, Teachers' Day, Environment Day, Independence Day, Gandhi Jayanthi, Republic Day, Onam and Christmas are observed and celebrated.

On the **Environment Day** A special assembly was organised and The Principal, Smt. Annamma Cherian distributed the saplings to the student leaders.

Flood relief activities While Kerala was hit by heavy floods as never before, we also tried to rise to the occasion by joining hands with the administration in the relief operations. The response from the students, parents and teachers was overwhelming. Food materials, clothes, cleaning materials, notebooks, other stationery items and donations worth Rs. 3,38,641/- could be collected and handed over to the needy people through the district administration and the Education department.

Food Festival As part of the club activities, a food festival was organised with the active participation of the students, teachers and parents, the proceeds of which have gone for social service activities. Fun games were also organised for the students. The Secretary Dr. Rajan Varghese, executive committee member Shri. Cherian Varghese and Principals of sister institutions visited the stalls.

Keralapiravi was celebrated with much hope and expectation for a rising Keralam. A special assembly was organised. Chendamelam, Thiruvathira, songs depicting Keralam, recitation and presentation of the products of Kerala which has won international acclaim were the highlights of the programme presented by the

students. The Chief Guest Dr. Rajan Varghese gave a beautiful and meaningful message which underlined the characteristics of God's own country and the people of Kerala.

Children's Day was celebrated with much enthusiasm and happiness. Right from the morning assembly to the special assembly for junior students which included songs, dance performances, storytelling, recitation and even magic show created a cheerful atmosphere. Fun games were also arranged for the primary students.

Christmas was celebrated on 7th December 2018. The nativity play, carol songs, skit and the arrival of Santa Claus spread the spirit of Christmas cheer in the air. The chief guest Rev. Vinith Mathew, the school chaplain, delivered a very meaningful Christmas Message. Christmas greetings were given by the respected Secretary, Dr. Rajan Varghese.

Value education classes are conducted on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8.15 am – 8.30 am by the respective class teachers. These classes are aimed at shaping and moulding young minds so as to help them become mature citizens. Graded textbooks are followed and tests conducted

Student Counselling

School Counsellor conducts sessions and class-wise interactions for a value based living of the students. It creates a healthy atmosphere in the school and enables the children to face the challenges that they encounter in school life. Parents and children frequently avail the service of the counsellor. Readers & Literary Club

As part of the Reading Week celebration, presentation of book review and appreciation of poetry was done by the students. The Inter-house Quiz, Inter-house Elocution, Inter-house drama and Inter-house debate are the main activities of this club. These competitions were organized separately for the 3 categories – Upper Primary, High School and the Higher Secondary.

Social Service Club

The Social Service club comprises of a group of students and teachers who work together for the welfare of the needy. The club members visited the nearby L P School with gifts for Christmas. Another visit was made to the Hospital Guidance and Counselling centre and lunch was sponsored to all the inmates.

Work Experience Club
