- ❖ Please submit the online form after completing all fields and uploading a copy of the **Birth Certificate**.
- ❖ Please note that candidates may select **only one school / stream**. The written test will be conducted on the same day at the school you have chosen.
- ❖ For **UKG admissions at the Mukkolakkal campus**, the evaluation will be held at **St. Thomas Residential School**, regardless of the specific school or stream selected.
- ❖ Admissions are subject to the **availability of vacancies**.

Lateral admissions procedure for **UKG, Std I to IX** will be as per the following schedule:

- a. Issue of application forms on the website : 2<sup>nd</sup> March to 1<sup>st</sup> April 2026
- b. Last date for submitting online forms : 1<sup>st</sup> April 2026
1. Lateral Admission/Evaluation Test : **10 am on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2026**. Parents may check the website for updates.
2. List of students granted admission : Tentatively on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2026 (will be published on the website).
3. **There will be no lateral admissions to Classes X and XII for the academic year 2026-27.**
4. **Instructions for written Lateral Admission Test**
  - (i) The Lateral Admission test will be conducted at the school opted for admission. Further details regarding the test will be available at the respective school offices.
  - (ii) Candidates are requested to report at least 20 minutes before the test, to find the assigned classroom.
  - (iii) Lateral admission tests are conducted for all classes in anticipation of future vacancies. Should a seat become available, admission will be granted based on the results of this test.
  - (iv) Admission to Class 1 is subject to State Government regulations regarding the minimum age requirement.
