- Issue of request forms on the website : 20th March to 4th April 2024
 - Last date for receipt of request forms : 8th April 2024
- Lateral Admission Test : **10 am on 13th April 2024.** Parents may check the website for updates.
 - List of students granted admission : Tentatively on 19th or 20th April 2024 (will be published on the website).
 - No lateral admission to Std. IX, X and XII in the academic year 2024-25.**
 - Instructions for written Lateral Admission Test**
 - The Lateral admission test will be conducted in the school opted for admission. Details of the test will be available in the respective schools.
 - Candidates are requested to report at least 20 minutes before the test, to find the assigned classroom.
 - Lateral admission tests will be conducted for all classes, in anticipation of future vacancies. If any vacancy arises in future, the results of this lateral test will be taken as basis for admission.
 - Admission to Class I will be subject to the decision of the State Govt., regarding minimum age.
